Overview

This analysis estimates the number of broadband serviceable locations (BSLs) without 100/20 Mbps terrestrial service that remain unfunded by any program even after accounting for BEAD awards. We compare scenarios that include or exclude satellite-based BEAD awards.

Locations vs. Units

Throughout this report, we report figures either in terms of “locations” or “units.” Locations are defined as a single Broadband Serviceable Location. Each “location” can have 1 or more “units.” For example, an apartment building with 12 apartments would represent 1 location and 12 units. Since a location has at least 1 unit by default, figures in “units” will always be either equal to or greater than figures by locations.

As shown in Table 1, approximately **1,101,356** locations without 100/20 Mbps service remain unfunded after all BEAD awards, or **1,629,240** if satellite BEAD awards are excluded. In terms of units, approximately **1,342,667** units remain, or **1,977,841** if satellite BEAD awards are excluded.

Unserved vs Underserved

Of the locations/units without 100/20 Mbps service remaining unfunded after BEAD, some are considered “underserved,” as service of 25/3 Mbps or faster is available, but not 100/20 Mbps or faster.

Methodology

Data Sources

FCC Broadband Funding Map (BFM): The location data comes from the FCC's Broadband Funding Map (as of January 21, 2026), which provides "a listing of locations...that are Unserved and/or Unfunded at various technology/speed combinations." The BFM accounts for funding from the following programs:

- **Appalachian Regional Commission** (Area Development, Partnerships for Opportunity and Workforce and Economic Revitalization)
- **Federal Communications Commission** (Bringing Puerto Rico Together, Connect America Fund Phase II, Connect USVI, Enhanced Alternative Connect America Cost Model, Rural Digital Opportunity Fund)
- **NTIA** (Broadband Infrastructure Program, Tribal Broadband Connectivity Program NOFO 1, Tribal Broadband Connectivity Program NOFO 2)
- **Rural Utilities Service** (COMMUNITY CONNECT GRANT PROGRAM, RURAL ECONNECTIVITY PROGRAM, TELEPHONE LOAN PROGRAM)
- **US Department of Treasury** (Capital Projects Fund, State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund)

BEAD Award Data: Location-level BEAD award data was compiled from states' BEAD Final Proposal data submissions. The latest data available at the time of this writing includes a mix of draft, submitted, and approved data files.

CostQuest Fabric Data: The number of units for locations in the BFM were retrieved using Version 7 of the Fabric.

Definitions

Without 100/20 (Unserved at 100/20): A location is considered "without 100/20" if it meets **both** of the following criteria in the BFM data:

- `terrestrial_dl100_ul20_r = 0` (residential)
- `terrestrial_dl100_ul20_b = 0` (business)

The "terrestrial" category includes wired technologies (fiber, cable, DSL) plus all fixed wireless technologies (both licensed and unlicensed), but excludes satellite. A value of 0 indicates the location has no existing 100/20 Mbps terrestrial service AND has not received funding for such service to be built.

We required **both** residential and business flags to equal zero to identify locations that are definitively without 100/20 service for all use cases, since the data does not distinguish whether a location is a residence or a business. This is the most conservative definition, yielding 3,379,711 locations nationally.

Underserved vs Unserved: Among locations without 100/20 Mbps service:

- **Underserved:** Has 25/3 Mbps terrestrial service but not 100/20
- **Unserved:** Does not have 25/3 Mbps terrestrial service

Funded vs Unfunded: Any location ID that received an award in BEAD or from any program in the BFM data is defined as "funded" and the remaining locations are defined as "unfunded."

Satellite BEAD Treatment

Results are presented both including and excluding locations that received BEAD funding for satellite internet service, since according to current FCC National Broadband Map data, nearly all locations in the country already have access to this type of service. As such, if satellite were to be included in measuring unserved locations before BEAD, there would be functionally 0 such locations.

BEAD Location Status

The BEAD Location Status table shows how BEAD award locations appear in the full BFM dataset (not just the without-100/20 subset). Categories are:

- **Not matched:** BEAD locations not found in the BFM at all
- **Without 100/20:** Both residential and business terrestrial 100/20 flags equal 0
- **Has only residential service:** Residential flag equals 100, business flag does not

- **Has only business service:** Business flag equals 100, residential flag does not
- **Has both services:** Both residential and business flags equal 100
- **Buildout in progress:** At least one flag is between 1-99 (funded but not yet built)

The table below shows what proportion of BEAD award locations appear in the BFM, and their status when matched.

Locations may not match for several reasons:

- Location IDs changed between BEAD eligibility determination and current BFM
- Locations were added or removed from the Broadband Serviceable Location Fabric
- Data quality issues in either dataset

The table below shows how BEAD location status varies depending on which technology types are considered when determining whether service is present.

Excluded “No BEAD” Locations

Except for locations deemed too expensive to serve, we do not count locations that states indicated in their Final Proposal data were intentionally excluded from receiving BEAD funding. In other words, these locations are not counted as remaining eligible locations.

States provided a reason code for why a given location was excluded. For “No BEAD” locations which matched to our list of remaining locations and were thus excluded from our totals, we summarize these reasons in the table below. Locations excluded from BEAD due to being “financially incapable” (reason code 7) are included in our remaining count, as these locations still lack service but could not be economically served under BEAD.
